The new wing of this iconic Murray-based property is anchored by a two-story Macy's and has a comfortable, spacious main concourse with soft seating and electrified charging bar seating areas, in a setting with clerestory windows and copious amounts of natural light. An extensive color palette with rich textures is reminiscent of natural stone and nicely complements existing buildings.

Vivid colors and rich textures are

reminiscent of natural stones of the local region and compliments the feel of the existing mall. An innovative structural system required close collaboration between the contractor and design team and reduced the project's budget and schedule. Construction crews took extra measures to ensure public safety during this complex expansion, building temporary demising walls to mitigate dust and noise.
